Harold opened the meeting with prayer.

There was one correction to the minutes from the April 21st meeting: a simulcast regarding the Global Methodist Church was held on *Saturday, May 7th, not Sunday, May 1st, as reported in the original minutes*. Motion by Janice to accept corrected minutes, 2nd by Bev; motion passed.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Expenses and revenue for 2022 thus far continue to run very close to budget. Motion to accept financial report by Wes, 2nd by Janice; motion passed.

PASTOR'S REPORT

Harold had a correction to the text of his letter that appeared in the "From The Pastor's Desk" column in the May newsletter. A corrected version will appear in the next newsletter.

OLD BUSINESS

Jody presented the bid he received from Mullin Awning and Siding for new windows in our fellowship hall and kitchen area. He, Susan, Randy and Harold met with a representative from Mullin and got answers to any remaining questions they had. We have adequate money in our Building Fund to cover the cost of the windows and their installation at this time. We will welcome any donations to offset the costs involved in this. The council decided that this will be our 60th Anniversary Project. Motion by Jody, 2nd by Janice to accept the bid from Mullin and move forward with the work. Motion passed.

60th Anniversary Update – Harold will work on getting contact information for all previous pastors in order to invite them to the celebration. Lisa is working on pulling together the Praise Band to perform during the service. Our new District Superintendent will be preaching that day. Service is at 9:30 with a lunch following from 11:00 am – 1:00 pm. The United Methodist Women will be serving a roast beef meal similar to what has been served at our Fair Stand annually. Janice and Mary will work on getting posters ready to announce the event to the public.

NEW BUSINESS

The owner of the property adjacent our church's south entrance would like to replace the wooden fence there. It was determined that the current fence is actually 10 feet over on our church's property. Harold and Wes will follow up with the owner and/or Mayor Jim Fisher to resolve this issue.

Sandy Baker has requested that we purchase 24 more upholstered chairs to be used in our Fellowship Hall for funerals and other events. Susan is working with Sandy on getting these ordered. Funds from the Memorial Account will be used for this purchase. There was a motion by Janice to use the church credit card for the purchase of the 10 chairs from Amazon There was a 2nd to that motion by Jeff, and the motion passed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

EDUCATION – Sunday School is over for this year. Janice reported that she is open to the idea of Dessert and Discussion group starting up. If anyone is interested, please contact Janice.

VBS will be hosted by Immaculate Conception Church this summer. It will run from June 26-30. Registration will be Sunday, June 26, from 2:30-5:00 pm. VBS will meet Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday for a meal at 5:30, followed by a session from 6:00-8:30 pm. The last session will be on Thursday, June 30th from 6-8:30 pm. Volunteers and children are needed!

MISSIONS – After making our payment of \$675.00, the balance in the Guatemalan Student account is \$203.95. This includes the May collection of \$156.65. The mission project for June is the Heifer Project.

TRUSTEES – Lisa, Eric Hansen and John Neely have been working on the sound system in the sanctuary. John has ordered a new part that we hope will help. Motion by Wes to reimburse John for the money spent, 2nd by Janice; motion passed.

UMW – There was a good group at May's meeting. Janice reported on her time spent at the Wesley Covenant Association's meeting on May 7th.

Our next Administrative Council Meeting will be Thursday, June 9th, at 7:00 p.m. All are invited to attend.
