### ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES – THURSDAY June 13, 2024

PRESENT: Susan Hunting, Mary and Jeff Krejci, Janice Schlotman, Kirk Scheelhaase, Jody Weaver, Gene Groetken

Susan opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes from the May 9, 2024, meeting were reviewed and no corrections were noted. Motion to approve by Janice, 2nd by Jody; minutes approved.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT**

May weekly giving was about \$2000 below budget. YTD actual income is \$36,600, as opposed to budgeted income of \$44,000.

Expenses for the month and YTD are very close to budget.

We sent in the bi-annual payment of \$550 for our Guatemalan student. This leaves the balance in that account of \$730.75.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Council discussed the need to fill the Lay Leader position in our church. Gene read the position as it was described in the Book of Discipline. We need to have a meeting with our pastor to determine his expectations of this position.

Kirk will call an SPRC meeting to discuss the open Lay Leader and Accompanist positions.

### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

FINANCE - Gene will be updating the scholarship application for Fall 2024. He hopes to have it back by the end of July for distribution in time for the next academic year.

Becky and others attended Risefest this year.

We prepared and sent off 19 kits for tornado response. We will continue to collect more supplies for more kits for Ingathering this fall.

In addition, we collected \$80 for lowa tornado support.

MEMBER SUPPORT AND EDUCATION - Diane is working on VBS. Dates for that are June 23rd - June 27th. The theme this year is "SCUBA - Diving into Friendship with God." All youth from the community are invited to attend.

The group mentioned that our congregation does a good job of checking on others in a kind of "informal outreach" network to make sure others are well.

SPRC - We are still looking for an accompanist for Sunday services. As mentioned earlier, we are also trying to fill the Lay Leader position and hope to meet with Pastor Eric soon to discuss these positions. TRUSTEES – Jody and Daryl have made sure our A/C is up and running well. Larry Etler is looking over our insurance policies.

UNITED WOMEN IN FAITH – The group met yesterday for the last time until September. Our guest speaker was an Education and Interpretation officer from the national UWIF organization.

Our next Administrative Council Meeting will be Thursday, July 11th, 6:00 p.m. All are invited to attend.

Living Heritage Foundation Scholarship Program

Another school year,

February to November, has begun for Leslie Jimenez who lives in Western Guatemala. Moville UMC is providing scholarship funds for a third year as Leslie enters 10th grade.

We also fund her participation in "Lifting Up my Student" which provides support with online courses and private tutors to help with subjects at school. Leslie's scholarship is totally funded by your donations (no money comes from the church budget). One-half of Leslie's yearly scholarship

of \$1,100 has been paid. A container remains on the table at the back of the sanctuary for your donation. Your help is really appreciated for the 2024 school year.

# HEIFER HIGHLIGHTS

Sharada and her husband Gulma struggled financially. She earned a pittance laboring on someone else's farm and he had to travel miles away to find work. Even with two incomes, they barely survived. When Heifer training came to her village, Sharada was able to grow her goat heard and soon her goats brought in enough income to allow Gulma to quit his job and return home. Sharada now earns ten times as much money as before and the family's basic needs are met. She hopes to buy land and build a better house with space for more goats.
